A word about tuition and the future.....

Last fall, the Board of Trustees conducted a comprehensive parent survey. The results of that survey assisted the Strategic Planning Committee in writing a Five Year Plan that will determine the goals of our school over the next few years. A copy of this plan is in your registration packet!

There are a number of initiatives in the Five Year Strategic Plan that we will be working on in the 2008-2009 school year. This year, the total tuition increase is \$100,000 and is divided between the following Strategic Initiatives:

- Increased Teacher Salaries - \$40,000
- Increased Teacher Training and Professional Development - \$10,000
- Addition of three new faculty positions including Spanish, an aide for PE and a half-time school nurse - \$20,000
- Facilities and Safety Initiatives which include the writing of a campus-wide crisis management plan, campus security plan and a master plan for our current facilities - \$5,000
- The committee assigned to research the viability of expansion to additional grades - \$5,000
- Ten year S.A.E.S. re-accreditation visit – February, 2009 - \$8,000
- Continued commitment to smaller class sizes, exceptional curriculum, enrichment subjects, technology and individualized attention - \$12,000

These initiatives require a significant amount of volunteer effort and financial resources, but they are worthy of our efforts. Additionally, this year marks the anniversary of our 60th year and our ten year re-accreditation visit by Southwestern Association of Episcopal Schools (S.A.E.S.). Both of these are important events in the life of our school and will require a tremendous amount of support by our faculty and our parents. As always, the Board of Trustees is committed to its function as a strategic entity, focusing on the long-term objective of making our school the best it can be!
