Students using the Internet at St. Alban's Episcopal Day School, Inc. are expected to use the same good behavior and judgment that is expected of them while in school. Access is a privilege, not a right. Students are expected to use the network to conduct research and to communicate with others; any other use of the internet will NOT be allowed. Students are responsible for their behavior and communications.

All students using the internet at St. Alban's Episcopal Day School, Inc. must have this form signed and on file before using the school's internet connection. Students using the internet will also have their parent's written permission on file as well.

Acceptable uses for the internet at St. Alban's Episcopal Day School, Inc. will include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. accessing a variety of educationally related materials,
2. sending or receiving e-mail that is educationally related,
3. accessing educationally related databases,
4. establishing a web page for St. Alban's Episcopal Day School

The following WILL NOT be permitted by students or staff with St. Alban's access to the internet:

1. sending or displaying offensive messages or pictures,
2. using obscene language,
3. harassing, insulting or attacking others,
4. damaging computers, computer systems, or computer networks,
5. violating copyright laws,
6. using another person's password,
7. trespassing in another's folders, work, or files,
8. intentionally wasting limited resources, including time,
9. employing the network for commercial purposes.

Persons violating this policy will not only lose access rights, BUT may face disciplinary as well as legal action.

I hereby agree to comply with this policy for internet access and communicate over the network in a reliable fashion while honoring all relevant laws and restrictions.
