### (Parker Uniforms)

# UNIFORM POLICY

2006-2007

Revised February 2004

*The purpose of wearing uniforms is so attention will not be focused on dress but on academics and character. A dress code gives children pride in their school, a feeling of belonging, and a sense of orderliness that will carry over into academic areas.*

Starting the FIRST DAY of school, students must be dressed in uniform. The uniform should be neat, mended, and clean at all times. Students must keep their SHIRTS tucked in and all students must maintain a neat and clean appearance. SHOES should fit well and be in good condition. SOCKS are required at all times. BELTS are required if shorts/pants have belt loops. Belts are not required for Preschool children 3 years old through kinder. UNDERSHIRTS must be white only (no printing).

Students may wear non-uniform "OUTERWEAR" to and from school and outside for play. Items such as sweaters and sweatshirts that will be worn throughout the day, both in class and out, must conform to the uniform "look". These items must be navy, dark green, or white and cannot have any writing on them. They can be purchased at Parker or elsewhere but they must conform to the uniform look.

St. Alban's T-shirts and BLUE denim jeans may be worn on Fridays only. These T-shirts are sold by the sixth grade class (sold at the beginning of the school year). Jeans worn on Fridays must be plain blue jeans, carpenter jeans, or capri jeans. They may not have embroidery, glitter or writing on them. They may not be bell bottomed, bleached, stone washed or have holes or frayed hems. Denim skorts, skirts, or shorts are allowed as long as they are the appropriate length and plain (again no fancy decorations).

Uniforms must be worn on all FIELD TRIPS. If a field trip is scheduled on a Friday, uniforms must be worn (not the St. Alban's T-shirt/blue jeans).

Special NON-UNIFORM days will be announced throughout the year (students may wear fancier jeans/shorts) as long as they are the appropriate length and not baggy, low cut or have holes or frayed hems. Children may choose to have a non-uniform day on their BIRTHDAY (or un-birthday).

A CHAPEL uniform has not been mandated. Any combination of the uniform items may be worn unless otherwise specified.
